## 2026 “NEW” Referee Course Instructions

*Upcoming NEW or First-Time Referees Courses are open!*

**Course Cost is \$75.00** (if over 18 years old an additional \$24.00 for 2-year background check). **Licenses will be valid until December 31, 2026.** Once expired, Referees do a Recertification Course annually. **All referee certifications are done through the US Soccer Learning Center.** The NEW Referee course is comprised of online assignments / Referee Course Modules **PLUS mandatory attendance at the 3- hour On-Field Training Session.**

**The online assignments / Referee Course Modules are:**

- Online Referee Course Modules (4) (Introduction, Preparing for, During & After the Game)
- Laws of the Game Update
- Introduction to Safe and Health Playing Environments
- First-Time Referee Quiz
- Background Check (if 18 years or older) – must CLEAR background screening before requesting attendance at the On-Field Training Session. Allow a minimum of 10-14 days for processing of Background Check.
- SafeSport Training (if 18 years or older)

When the above Modules are 100% complete, then attendance at an In-person On-Field Training Session can be scheduled. These session will be held: **February – April, 2026 on Saturdays and Sundays from either 8:00 am – 12:00 pm or 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm.**

### To register for a NEW First-Time Referee course:

1. Go to US Soccer's Learning Center at: <https://Learning.ussoccer.com/referee>.
2. If you have not set up a profile, you must click on **SIGNUP**, in the upper right, complete all information to create your Learning Center Account and click Continue.
3. Once your profile is set up, simply log in. While logged in, click on **COURSES** at top of the page, goes to **AVAILABLE COURSES**, OR, in **another webpage**, go to this course (click on this link) while logged in to the Learning Center on another tab: <https://learning.ussoccer.com/referee/courses/available/10000006/list>, which shows **2026 WI New Referee Course-Register here**. If it comes up to a page that says **UPCOMING FIRST-TIME REFEREES** and just lists courses in other states, on that page, click **HOST**, go to the bottom of the list and select Wisconsin State Referee Committee.
4. Click on **COURSE DETAILS >** on the right to register for online assignments.
5. Once registered, click on **COURSES** at top, then **MY COURSES**, then **RESUME/Red Arrow** and click on the **ASSIGNMENTS** tab at top of page to complete the online requirements. Assignments will show in **GREEN** and marked "satisfactory" when completed.
6. When the Online Assignments are 100% completed, email [sue@wisref.org](mailto:sue@wisref.org) to request a Field Training Session. Online assignments need to be completed 48 hours before the start of a requested Field Training Session. There are NO refunds.

**WisRef has partnered with the WYSA to offer a \$40.00 reimbursement for those who successfully complete the 2026 requirements to be registered as a NEW Referee. The reimbursements will be processed a couple months following the in-person training session.**

### NEW! No Show Ref Policy

#### *What happens if there is no referee for a game?*

Milwaukee Kickers Soccer Club works with its ref assigners to do its best to ensure a referee is assigned to every recreational game. We understand with the ongoing referee shortage that there are some games that go uncovered.

1. Head Coaches should meet before the match to confirm no referee is present.
2. See if there is a mutual option that both coaches can agree upon.
3. If no mutual option is agreed upon, it is the HOME team's responsibility to fill the referee.
4. Use a pre-designated coach or parent if possible.
5. If no pre-designated coach or parent is available, find a volunteer to referee the game (i.e. parent, spectator, older player, etc.)

This policy is ONLY for teams participating in MKSC Recreational League.

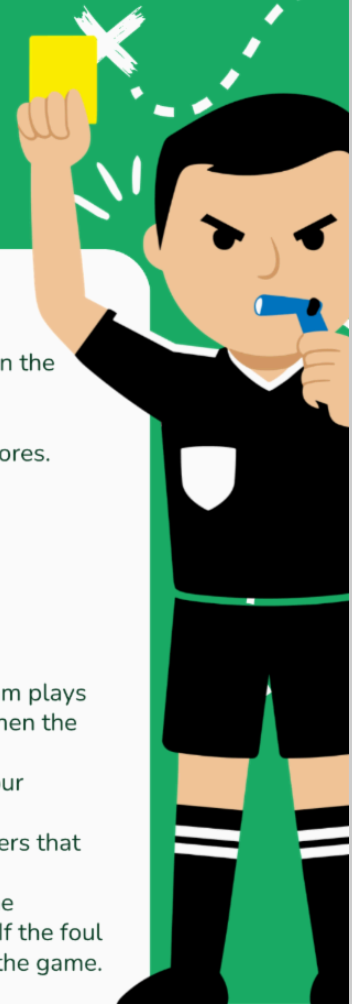


## CLARIFYING THE CALL PLAYOFF TIE-BREAKER REGULATIONS

*During the Playoffs, games tied at the end of regulation will be broken with sudden-death player elimination overtime.*

### Rules:

- The game will be played in one-minute sudden death periods.
- Only the players on the field at the end of the game will be allowed to participate in the overtime.
- Each minute period will be started with a drop ball at midfield.
- Each team will remove one player after each one-minute period in which no one scores.
  - In the case of specific coed leagues:
    - The first player to be eliminated will be a male player.
    - Player 2 will be a male player.
    - Player 3 to be removed will be a female player.
    - Player 4 will be a male player.
    - Player 5 will be a male player.
    - The last player to be removed will be a female player.
- There are no substitutions allowed. If a player is injured during a period, his/her team plays short for the remainder of the period. If the game is at goalkeeper vs. goalkeeper, then the team with the injured player forfeits due to being unable to field a team.
- After the tiebreaker reaches 2v2 (last 2 players) you may only score from within your attacking third of the field.
- You may change your goalkeeper at the end of each minute period among the players that are on the field.
- If a penalty is called for a breakaway foul that denies a goal scoring opportunity, the offending player is ejected for the rest of that one minute where the foul occurred. If the foul happens when the game is goalkeeper vs. goalkeeper, the offending team forfeits the game.
