# Milwaukee Kickers Soccer Club

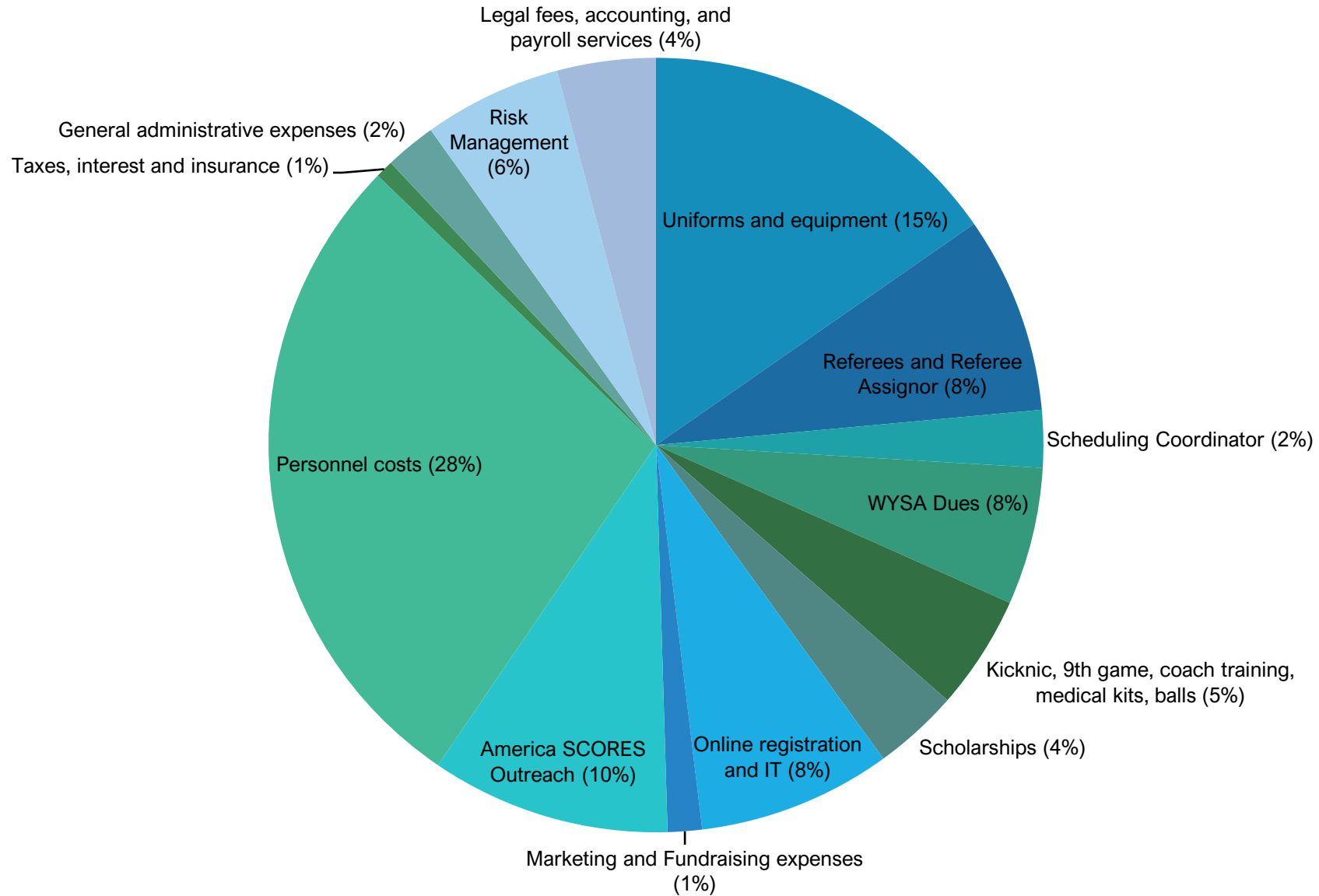

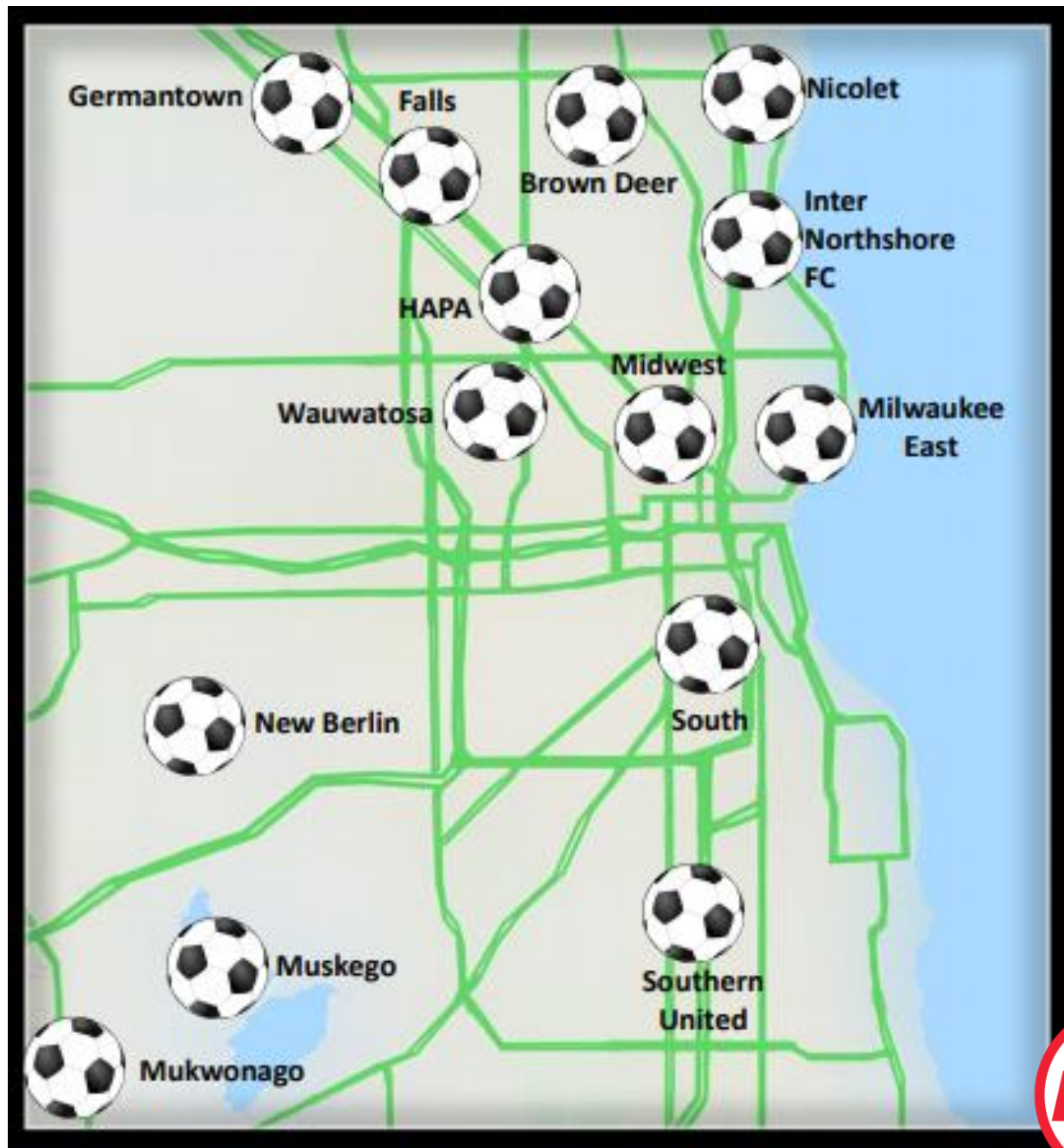

# Regions

# Registration Update: Fall 2020/Spring 2021

As of Wednesday, July 22 we have approximately 2,350 players registered for the Fall 2020/Spring 2021 Season.

We encourage anyone who has not yet registered to register no later than August 1. After that date, teams are formed, uniforms are ordered, and schedules are made.

# Refund/Credit Policy & Optional Insurance

This year, we have partnered with USSCI to offer OPTIONAL insurance coverage on your fees. This insurance covers your fees in the event of injury, illness and/or job loss (among others). # Muskego Region Example

As we have discussed, you pay two fees when you register for MKSC. The first is to Kickers and the second is to your region. In this example, we are using the Muskego region to demonstrate how refunds would work. Please note: all regions have varying refund/credit policies.

Cost to Register a U9 player: \$200 for both Fall and Spring Season

- \$150 is for Milwaukee Kickers Fees
- \$50 is for Muskego Regional Fees

If the Fall Season is cancelled: \$35 from MKSC and \$25 from Muskego = \$60 total for Fall

If the Spring Season is cancelled: \$35 from MKSC and \$25 from Muskego = \$60 total for Spring

If both seasons are cancelled = \$120 back (60% of your initial payment)



# Why can't you refund 100% of the fees?

There are several costs that are incurred when you register that can not be recouped and/or are paid to third parties. Some examples of those include:

- Personnel Costs
- America SCORES Outreach
- Uniforms & Other Equipment
- Online Registration Platform Fees
- General Administrative Costs/Processing Fees

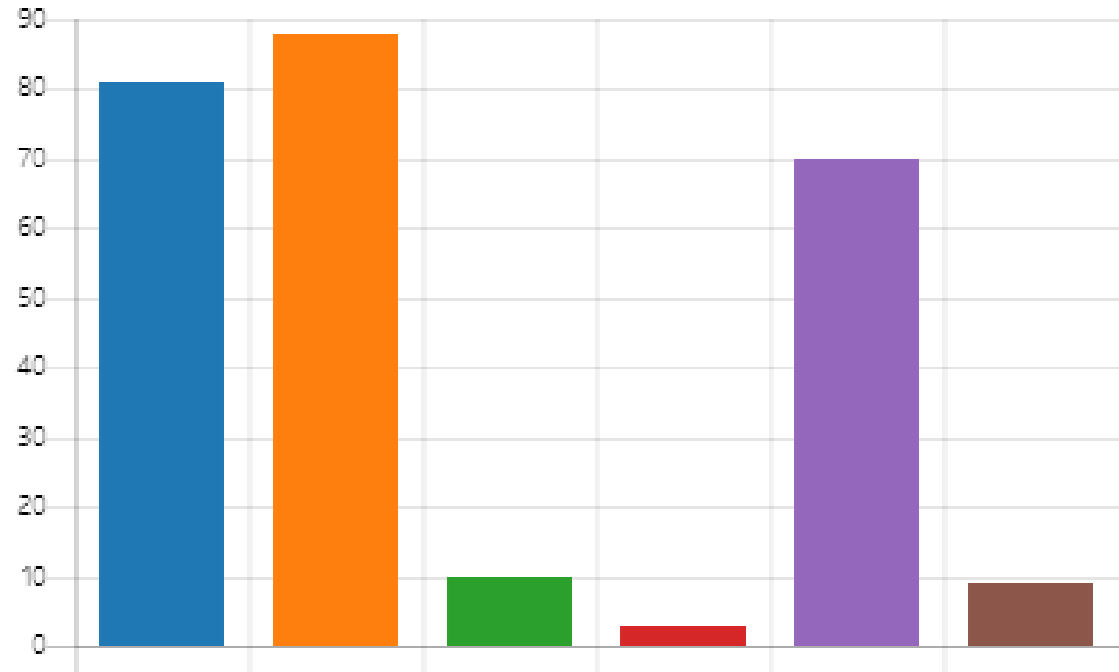

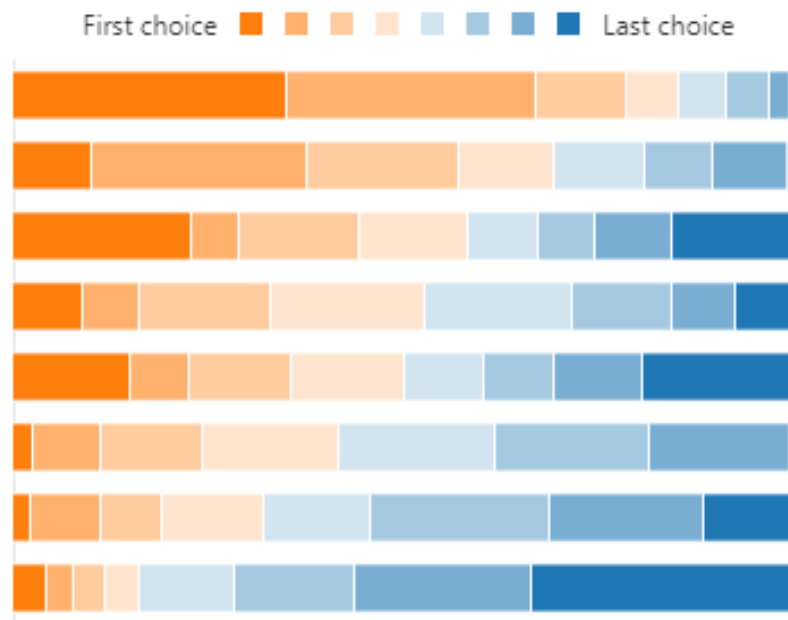

# WYSA's Return to Play Phased Approach

As a member of the Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association (WYSA), MKSC will follow the WYSA Return to Play guidelines. WYSA has adopted US Soccer's Play On plan. That plan can be found here: [WYSA Return to Play Guidelines](#).

The state of Wisconsin is currently in [Phase II](#) of the Return to Play plan. This Phase allows for socially distant group/team training and some small group-sided play, with many other safety measures in place such as masks, sanitation and tracked attendance for contact tracing.



# What Will Fall Look Like?

We are optimistic that we will be in at least Phase III by the start of the fall season. This phase allows for local game play. Having said that, there are certainly no guarantees that we will have a season “as normal.” MKSC is committed to providing soccer programming no matter which phase we are in.

All coaches will be required to complete training regarding COVID-19 safety procedures and regulations, so they are prepared to welcome your child(ren) back to play. We are also providing coaches with hand sanitizer and antibacterial wipes to clean equipment, as necessary.

*Some Best Practices to Keep in Mind:*

- Do NOT come to training if you feel ill. Notify your coach immediately.
- Do NOT come to practice if you have been in contact with someone who has (or suspects they may have) COVID-19.
- Practice social distancing, wash your hands, and sanitize all clothes and equipment before and after training.
- Drop your child(ren) off at training or wait in the car while they practice.
- Ensure your child(ren) is prepared for practice. Provide them hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes, their own ball and water.
