

2019 MKSC Futsal League Rules

Every Team will play 4 games

- U7-U8 4 vs 4 (NO GK)
- U9-U10 GK + 5 vs 5 + GK
- U11-U12 GK + 5 vs 5 + GK
- U13-U14 GK + 5 vs 5 + GK
- HIGH SCHOOL GK + 4 vs 4 + GK
- Game duration: 56 minutes of continuous play
- A whistle or horn will sound to start (00:00) and end (00:56) playing time.
- Before the game starts coaches should consult to decide on when halftime/breaks should take place as well as any rule modifications or changes. If coaches can't come to an agreement then these rules should be followed.
- U7-U8 SIZE #3 Futsal Ball
- U9-HS SIZE #4 Futsal Ball
- NO HEADING for U7-U12
- NO PUNTING.
- Balls out of bounds (sideline) will be restarted by a Kick in (pass) or Dribble the ball in (player choice) from close to where the ball crossed sideline to go out of bounds. The ball must not be moving before a player decides to restart play.
- Goal Kick will start from the goal keeper's hands. All opposing players must exit the arc (goal area) in a timely manner.
- Defending team should retreat 15 feet on all restarts.
- Ball can be passed back to the Goalkeeper, but Goalkeeper cannot use hands when dealing with the ball. If handling occurs then an indirect free kick will be awarded and the ball place at the closest point on the arc (goal area).
- Tripping, pushing or a hand ball inside the arc by the defensive team will result in a penalty (direct) kick from the penalty spot.

- All other restarts are indirect(ball has to be touched twice before a goal can be scored)
- Substitution happen on the fly. The players entering the game must wait until the exiting player has left the playing field before they can go onto the field
- Teams should wear game uniforms
- Team/coach should have set of pennies in case of jersey color clash
- Players must wear shin guards under their socks
- **NO cleats allowed only flat soled shoes.**
- Game ball will be provided by the Kickers
- Futsal League Team Roster is unrestricted
- Games will be played without referees/ calls are made by the players or coaches. When in conflicting situation coaches will make the call
- Team that is losing by more than three goals will have two options:
 1. Can add a player on the field/after consultation with the opposing coach
 2. When option # 1 does not work coaches should consult to find workable solution. Additional players added and or mixing up teams/players in order to maintain level of the game competitiveness.
